Here is a brief Program Development committee report from last week's camp. I agree wholeheartedly with Stella's email below. It was a wonderful week....fun and enriching for everyone involved. Gilley and Petra really are a class act....we paid them for 100% and they gave out 150%! They thanked us profusely, said they had a wonderful time and can't wait to do it again.

We ended up with 16 skaters attending camp...Magali was sick all week, but we picked up a couple of part-time skaters: Mike M. for a few days, Sammy Starks for a day, and Kristin couldn't resist joining the group classes.

Here's the summary of recouped expenses. Every one of Gilley's possible 56 private lessons were filled, and Petra taught an additional 31 private lessons, paid directly to her (\$1,550.00). FFSC paid out \$500.00 in sponsored half-lessons with Gilley: these were utilized by 6 skaters (Michael, Leah R., Hannah, and Shawna utilized the full \$100 benefit, and Jenna and Jordan utilized \$50 each). Five non-FFSC skaters participated in the full week of camp.

Income generated:

\$2,300.00 (56 Gilley lessons @ \$50 each: this equals \$2,800 but the club sponsored \$500)

\$1,400.00 (5 camp registrations: 3 @ \$300, and 2 siblings @ \$250 each)

\$3,700.00 Total

Thanks to everyone who helped make the camp such a nice success! Leo was absolutely wonderful....thought he might

cry saying goodbye to Gilley! Sue and I talked about getting him a \$100 gift certificate to Sportsman's Warehouse as an extra thank-you.
